
Jamal Musiala German Bundesliga 2023/24 **Scouting Report**



Musiala excels at pressing, dribbling, and finishing.




Jamal Musiala is a young, developing winger at Bayern München who excels in many aspects of the game. During this season, he has been outstanding in pressing and recovering the ball high up the field. He is an excellent finisher, consistently converting his chances, and his dribbling skills make him a significant threat when moving forward. Musiala is also highly effective in his overall play, evidenced by his positive impact per reception, and is good at providing teammates, box threat, and passing quality.






Left winger with superb finishing ability.



J. Musiala is an excellent finisher for a left winger, consistently scoring more goals than expected. While his shot conversion and shot quality remain average, his overall goal-scoring ability sets him apart.

This season, J. Musiala was exceptionally effective when shooting from the right side of the box, making him a lethal threat from that area. He also performed quite well in the golden zone, but his conversion rates outside the box and from the left were just average.



demonstrating remarkable skill. At 20, Musiala is anticipated to maintain his high-level finishing, with the next season expected to see continued outstanding performance.




Effective left winger with impressive box threat.



As a left winger, J. Musiala stands out for his ability to threaten the box with exceptional skills in getting touches in the box, scoring goals, and receiving the ball in dangerous areas. Although his box entries and expected goals are typical for the league, his overall threat in the penalty area is impressive.

Musiala has an average performance in generating scoring opportunities from all regions: the golden zone, the left and right sides of the box, and outside the box. He often settles for safer options.



Versatile and effective chance creator.



J. Musiala is highly effective at creating chances, especially with deep completions, second assists, and generating expected goals through his passes. His numbers in key passes and assists are respectable, making him a well-rounded player in terms of chance creation.

Musiala excelled in creating chances from the attacking central zone and right half-space, showcasing his ability to impact the game centrally compared to other left-sided wingers. However, he was only average in the penalty area and less effective on the wings, suggesting a preference for operating more centrally.










Superb dribbler from the left wing.




Versatile player with exceptional left-sided runs.



J. Musiala is a very good runner compared to other left wingers, strongly excelling in carrying the ball, making dangerous runs, and receiving the ball in the penalty area. He performs well across the board, with average performance when it comes to getting into the box or making deep runs.

J. Musiala has been exceptional with his carries in the left-sided and central attacking zones, creating significant threats. However, he operates less effectively on the right flank, showing a distinct preference for left-sided play and central penetration for ball-carrying impact.




Great at creating opportunities for others.




Musiala stands out for creating dangerous opportunities with his passing in the final third and overall passing quality. However, he could improve his ability to deliver dangerous crosses, though he is generally strong overall when he has the ball.

Musiala stands out for his exceptional passing in the attacking central zone and left half-space. He is highly effective in the opposition penalty area and attacking right half-space, although his influence wanes notably on the defensive right wing and half-space and when playing on the attacking right wing.




Musiala excels in left-wing pressing.



J. Musiala's pressing is unparalleled, as he excels in all facets of the defensive game for a left winger. His ability to recover the ball, apply defensive intensity, make interceptions, and execute counterpressing recoveries is exceptional, making him extremely effective in disrupting the opposition's play.

Musiala's defensive intensity stands out notably in the attacking central zone and defensive left half-space, with excellent contributions in the attacking left half-space and wing. However, his defensive efforts drop substantially on the right side of the pitch.



after transitioning to a midfielder. At 20, he's likely to maintain this average pressing, with some potential for improvement. Next season, his pressing could vary, but it might often be average.






Versatile and creative midfielder.



J. Musiala's creative play is excellent and he works hard defensively. However, he is not very gifted in the air and does not receive a lot of touches on the ball.


Musiala's contributions were outstanding in both the attacking right and left half-spaces, indicating a high involvement in central attacking play. His role in the wider attacking areas was below average, suggesting his impact is more significant when operating centrally.

Musiala burst onto the scene with Bayern München at just 17, initially impressing as a winger with outstanding involvement. However, after transitioning to a midfielder, his performance became more average. Now 20, while still possessing significant talent, his involvement in matches is expected to remain at an average level in the near future. His performance next season might range from below average to good, depending on how he adapts and grows in his role.
